4. **Write an essay entitled “The Tuskegee Airmen” expressing how the Tuskegee Experience impacts your life and opportunities and the lives of people today. (Typed double spaced, minimum of 500 words.) *This essay must be in your own words.***
5. **Each applicant must submit a two (2)-page essay containing a brief biographical statement, educational aspirations, career goals and an explanation of why financial aid is essential. (Typed double-spaced, not to exceed two (2) pages.)**
6. **A detailed list of Extracurricular and Community Activities (including Junior ROTC, Civil Air Patrol, BSA, GSA, Explorer Scouts.) Please include the years of participation and verification of your participation. Use a separate page for this information.**

Incomplete applications will be automatically disqualified.

Completed applications and supporting documents must be postmarked by April 15, 2026.

The Tuition Assistance Award will be sent directly to your college of choice following receipt of an official letter from the college (on school letterhead with the school seal embedded in the letter), confirming your enrollment and registration for fall semester classes.
